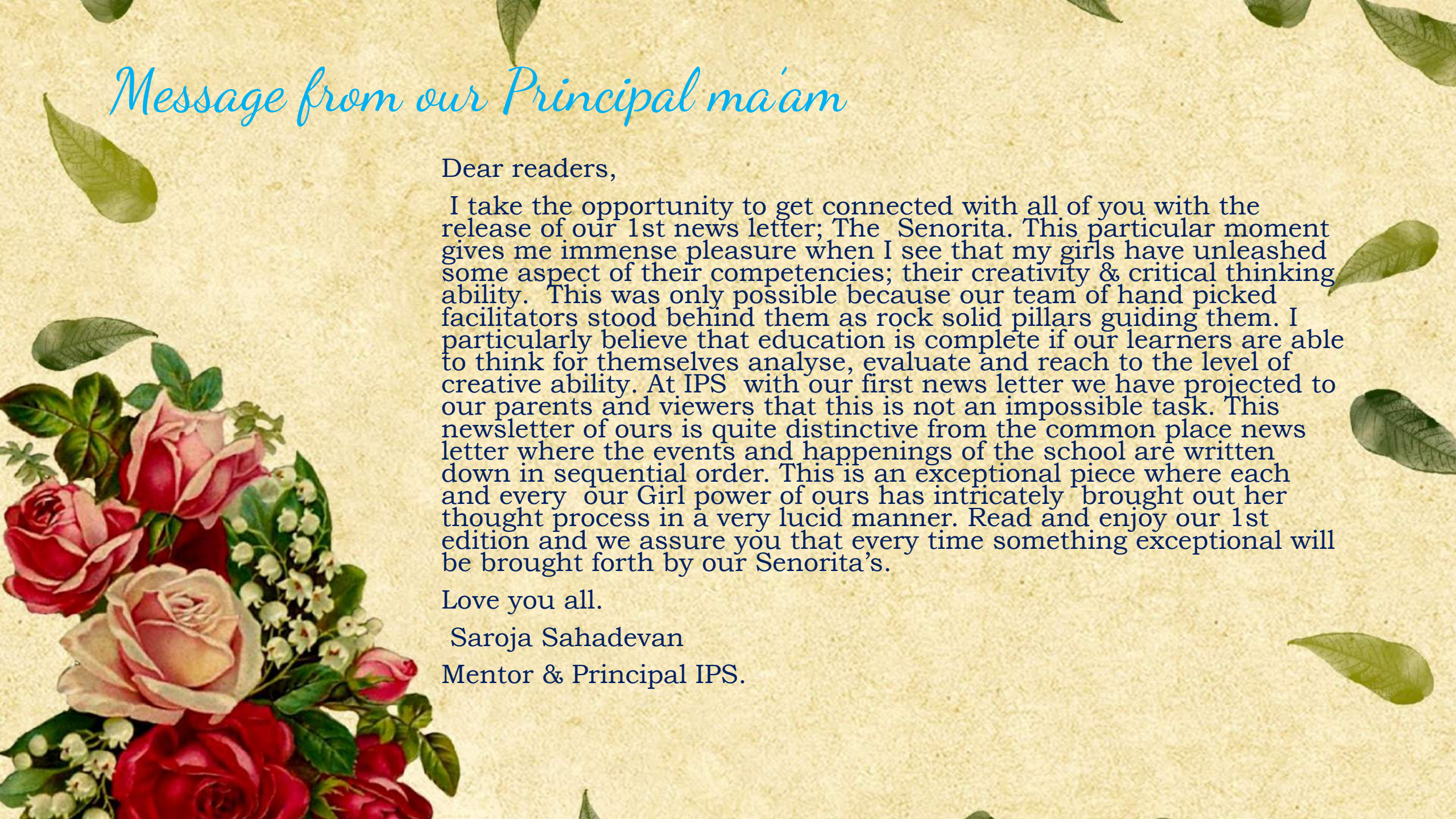
# *Message from our Principal ma'am*

- Adding Dance and music to their academic will make them better students in life.

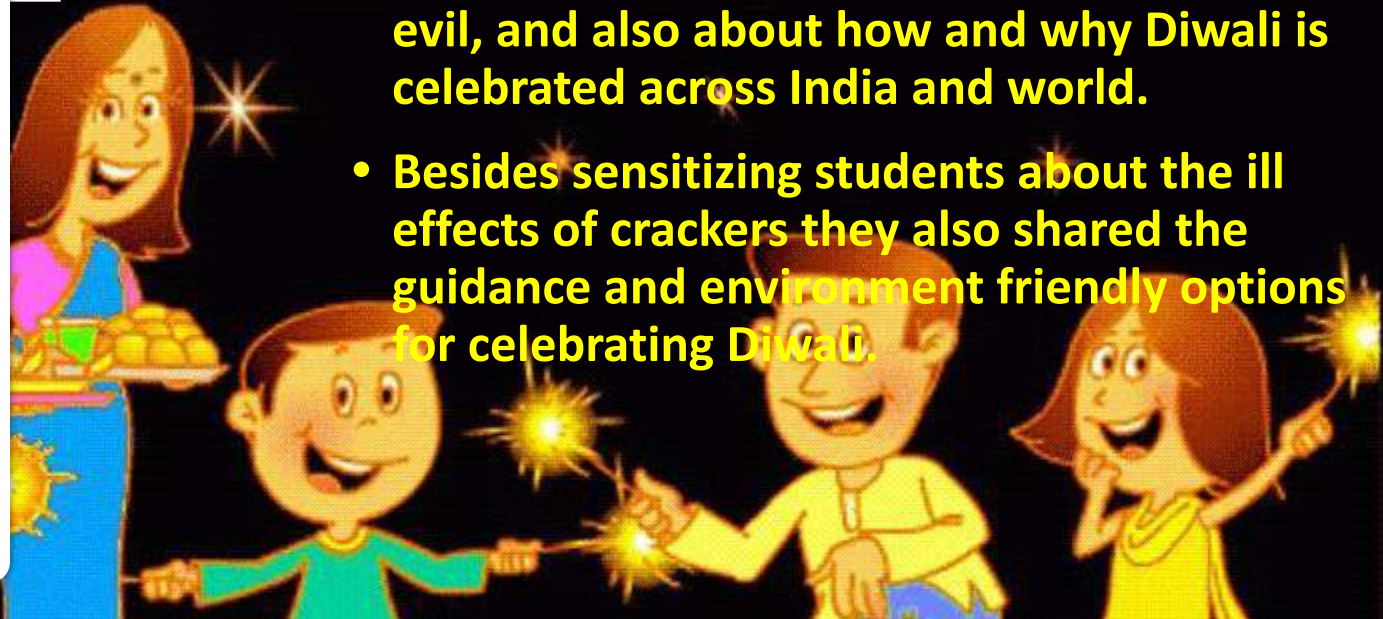




# Diwali celebration

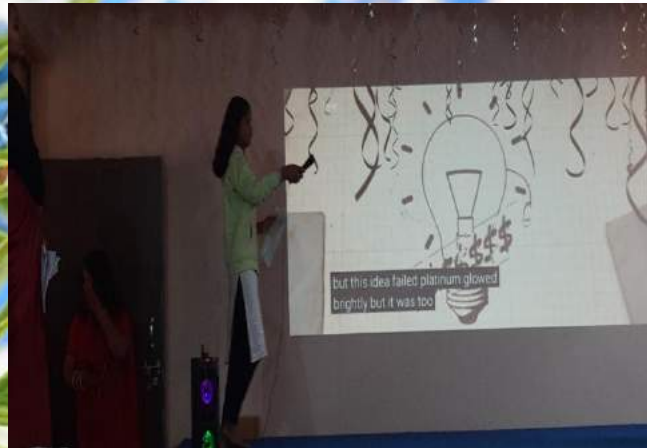








# Winter Carnival:
